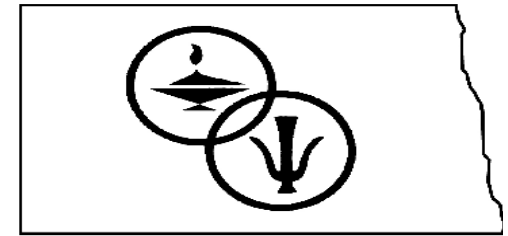

Special Education Law and Ethics of Manifestation Determination-NASP Webinar

This session will review the laws and regulations associated with the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) governing special education student discipline and will offer detailed discussion on convening manifestation determination meetings. A PowerPoint presentation will be supplemented with excerpts from legal decisions.

Writing Useful and Legally Defensible Psychoeducational Reports

Effective evaluations call for organized and useful reports that are understandable and helpful for parents and educators working with the child. School psychologists must also meet state and federal laws and regulations. Both objectives can be accomplished. This workshop will clarify characteristics of effective reports, review research on report writing, examine legal mandates, and discuss strategies for making reports useful and understandable. Report examples will be used to demonstrate effective writing practices and common pitfalls.
