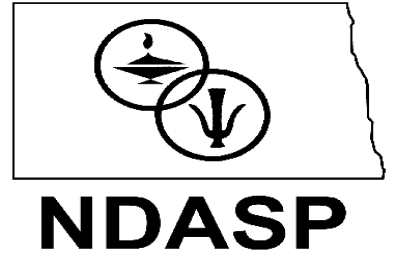


School Psychologist of the Year Nomination Form

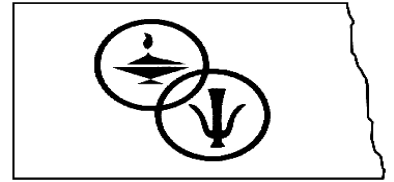
